The wired remote control starts and stops the rotation of the bend pin. An optional bar stop is available that can be set at almost any angle for an automatic stop and a repeatable angle setting.

Compatible machines for the rebar attachment include all Bobcat® skid-steer loaders, compact track loaders, all-wheel steer loaders and Toolcat utility work machines.
